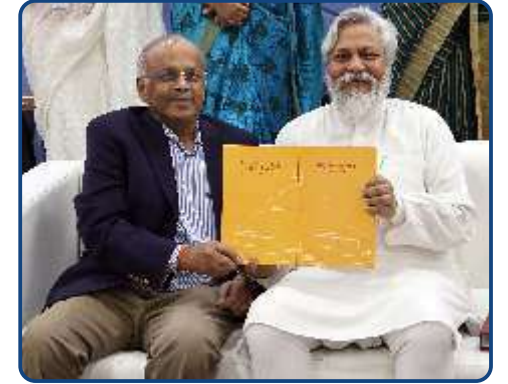
DR. RAJARAM JAIPURIA HONOURED AT CITI AWARDS 2024
